The district has a population density of 992 inhabitants per square kilometre (2,570/sq mi). Its population growth rate over the decade 2001-2011 was 30%. Araria has a sex ratio of 921 females for every 1000 males, and a literacy rate of 55.1%. 6.00% of the population lives in urban areas. Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes make up 13.61% and 1.38% of the population respectively.

Some children get rejected by their families for small body deformities and treatable medical conditions, some have totally both parents as a result of HIV/AIDS pandemic, some escape the torment of child labour and abuse from often relatives who offer to take them in after the death of their parents. Others are abandoned on the streets of where they risk a lot fending for a living. Because every child is precious to God, we cannot sit back and watch these children suffer alone yet we can do something to restore their priceless lives and provide them with hope for the future. This we have managed to achieve through our Childcare/Orphanage ministry under our internal sector within the Institution.

14. Activities Of The Organisation:-

BHARTI SEWA SADAN NURSHING HOME PROGRAMME.-

The Organization conducted the programme in Araria District of Bihar State. A nursing home is a facility for the residential care of elderly or disabled people. Nursing homes may also be referred to as skilled nursing facility (SNF), long-term care facilities, old people's homes, care homes, rest homes, convalescent homes or convalescent care. Often, these terms have slightly different meanings to indicate whether the institutions are public or private, and whether they provide mostly assisted living, or nursing care and emergency medical care. Nursing homes are used by people who do not need to be in a hospital, but cannot be cared for at home. PLANTATION PROGRAMME.-

Afforestation is the planting or adding of trees in an area where there was never a forest or plantation. The most common and known purpose of tree plantation is forestry. The forest is very important for maintaining the ecological balance of the environment of the earth. Also, earlier the forest use to cover a major part of the surface of the earth. 16. Project Methodology:-

We have been identifying orphan / semi orphan / street children through our volunteers, Citizens, police, women & child welfare department. We Pre-view of the incoming orphan / semi orphan / street child problems / difficulties. We counsel and arrange for Emotional acceptance of the orphan / semi orphan / street child. We provide Lodging and boarding facilities for all inmates at a rented building in **BHARTI SEWA SADAN TRUST** of the at Araria District. We arranged teaching facilities in nearby schools according to their age. We also provide home tuitions, recreation and health care.

We have been running the Orphanage with local donations and contributions only. We mobilizing both cash and kind. We have limited resources to take care of about 100 orphan / Semi orphan / Street children. But, day by day number of children is increasing due to various reasons. We need additional support from the donors and philanthropists to meet the needs of increasing orphan / semi orphan / street children in our centre.

We seek support for three (3) years. Meanwhile we will sustain to mobilize continues local donations through exhibiting our good work and service. We are planning to build permanent home by acquiring land from the donors and philanthropists.

This home will have required personnel that are mentioned in budget section. All the inmates will be provided with health check-up, medicines, food, cosmetics, one set of books and two sets of uniform every year. The proposal covers 100 orphans. Every child will be provided with nutritional diet, indoor and out-door recreation and play facilities and training in crafts and hobbies.

19. Problem Statement:-

The problem of orphan / street children is acute due to urbanization and industrialization. Recent floods in our area aggravated the situation further. Due to the Deaths of AIDS affected persons. Re-marriage of widows/ divorced/ women, Absence of love and security, Unrented pregnancy of sexual exploited girls these orphan & street children are left without care and support. These children are involved in rag picking; pick pocketing & participating in anti-social, criminal activities.

How will this project solve this problem?

We have been identifying orphan & street children, Pre-viewing, counselling & providing lodging and boarding facilities for all inmates. We are arranging teaching facilities in nearby schools & providing home tuitions. Health check- ups, medicines, cosmetics. One set of books & 2 sets of uniform every year. This proposal covers 100 orphans, poor & street children. Every child is being provided with nutritional diet. Indoor & outdoor recreation and play facilities and training in craft and hobbies.

Potential Long Term Impact:-

This project has potential & impact full in main streaming or poor orphans & street children. Their basic needs are met & they will get new life through gaining knowledge, vocational skills & life skills. They will get love & affection as if their parents provides. Their confidence level will increase and become good asset to the community. They are developed physically & psychologically & made as good & productive citizens. They will inspire by philanthropy & show humanity towards the community.

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20. Economic Dependency:-

As per the 52nd round of National Sample Survey Organization, nearly half of the children are fully dependent on others. While another 20% are partially dependent for their economic needs. The situation is even worse for female children. The children living with their families are largely contingent on the economic capacity of the family unit for their economic security and wellbeing. Most of the families do not have financial protection such as sufficient income and other form of social security in India. The single most pressing challenge to the welfare of children care is poverty, which is a multiplier of risk for abuse. Also due to their financial dependence, children are most vulnerable to infections have low priority for their own health, lack of proper care in the family, insufficient housing, economic hardship and break up of joint family have made the children seem more relevant even in the Indian context **BHARTI SEWA SADAN TRUST** has identified these needs and to provide the children with the required support, the organization is proposing to build a Children Home for 100 children from all over our Project area.

21. The Role and Function of the Donor Agencies:-
